Established in 2001, Waipara Hills is an award winning wine range from the South Island of New Zealand. Recipient to over 500 medals Waipara Hills has developed a fine reputation for crafting rich aromatics, with vibrant, complex flavour.

The Waipara Hills Cellar Door is located in the picturesque Waipara Valley, a short scenic drive north of Christchurch. Set amongst landscaped gardens, with spectacular views across The Home Block Vineyard to the Teviotdale Hills, our home captures the 'Soul of the South'.

VINTAGE CONDITIONS

2016 was a stable and warm season with dry conditions, without being too hot. This produced lifted aromatics of great weight and interest, resulting in spectacular wines.

VINIFICATION

Parcels were brought into the winery and quickly pressed and run to tank to protect from oxidization. The juice was settled, then racked, warmed and inoculated with a range of aromatic yeasts. After approximately four weeks the ferments were finished. The wines were chilled and topped so that the aromatic flavours were released from the yeast lees. After another four weeks the wines were racked, and warmed ready for blending, after which they were fined using traditional methods to promote vitality and freshness.

WINE:	2016 Waipara Hills Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc
COLOUR:	Pale green and straw
NOSE:	Vibrant melon, snow pea and wet river stone with a touch of tropical fruit.
PALATE:	Bursting with rich, ripe fruit. This wine has a wonderful mouthfeel and a bright refreshing finish.
SERVE:	Chilled and matched with fresh flavours such as a Summer salad filled with garden greens and slices of orange and fennel.
CELLARING:	Drink young to capture the fresh, crisp flavours.
ANALYSIS:	ALC 13% ACIDITY (TA): 7.01 pH 3.25
